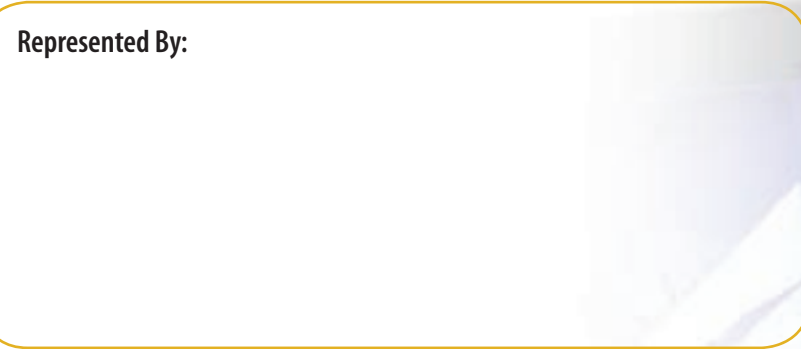

### Superb audio quality

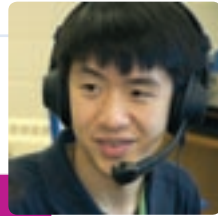

### Compelling multimedia activities

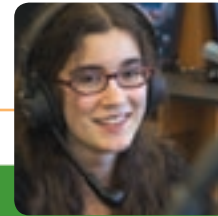
Instructors can assign reading/viewing, recording, and writing activities that employ audio, video, text, images, and captions to stimulate student participation.
